MESSAGE FROM BISHOP MIEHM

“I rejoiced when I heard them say
Let us go to the House of the Lord.
And now our feet are standing
Within your gates, O Jerusalem.”

This psalm captures our mood as we return
to the house of the Lord after a long absence,
brought on by the pandemic restrictions of
COVID-19. This is a day of rejoicing, when

we can return to the public celebration of the
sacraments, be nourished both by God's

charity and concern for our neighbours, with
a conviction to help in any way we can and
with a renewed appreciation for the
sacraments and the riches of our faith.
Above all, let us give thanks to God who
guards our coming and going, and let us
gather with rejoicing in this house of the
Lord.
