FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

COVID-19: As numbers continue to rise again, I want to remind you that it is your Christian and moral responsibility to **wear your mask and sanitize your hands while entering and exiting the Church.** Some people are slipping in this responsibility--so I am reminding all of you again. I don't want to embarrass anyone by barring their admission to the Church, but I **will** do it. People come up from Toronto and Peel Region all the time to this

I'll wager that very few of you have wondered where some of our common every day words come from. Here is some trivia for you!!

"MASS" comes from the Latin for "sent" (Missa). So, Mass does not mean a mass of people; it means that we are being "sent" back to world with the grace of Holy Communion within us, to "love and serve the Lord".

"CREED" comes from the Latin for "I believe". This statement of Faith that we profess each Sunday is *not a prayer*--it is the outward and vocal profession of Faith by members of the Christian community.

"GOOD-BYE" is a shortened version of "God be with you". So hopefully every time you say "goodbye", you are blessing someone!

"HOCKEY" (to some people a real blessing!) comes from the French phrase "la hocque" which means "hook". So, an ice game using a hooked stick became hockey.
