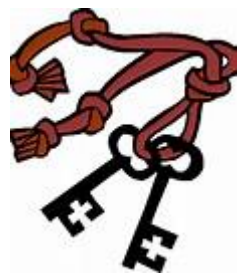

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

### **WHAT IS A DIOCESE?**

(Pronounced *dio-seez*) *Our Parish  
and mission churches* are part of  
the Diocese of Peterborough of 40  
parishes, with Bishop Miehm (or  
called the "Ordinary" as our  
shepherd.

A Diocese is a geographical area--  
some Diocese are small, some are  
large. A large Diocese (a  
combination of geographical area  
and number of Catholics) is called  
an Archdiocese, with an Archbishop  
as the shepherd of the people.  
Canada has 71  
Dioceses/Archdioceses.

The Chancery Office is the central  
kitchen of the Diocese. It houses  
the Bishop's Office, marriage  
tribunal for annulments, the Vicar  
General's Office, and financial and  
pastoral offices as well. It also  
houses the archives of the Diocese  
(archives meaning sacramental  
records from each parish) historical  
documents and historical items.
