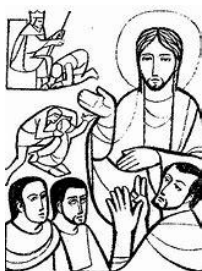

### **FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK**

**2020-2021 SUNDAY MISSALS** have been ordered and will be available in the next couple of weeks. I have ordered 50. \$5 a

copy--first come first served! They will be available beginning the first Sunday in November. The new Missal starts with the first Sunday of Advent (a few weeks away). You **must** take your Missal home with you after each Mass during this Covid-19 period. There will be no copies left in the pew racks.

### **How much do Sacraments cost??**

Answer--nothing! Contrary to some opinion, the Church cannot "charge" for any Sacrament. However, "suggested offerings" are set by the Bishop's Office in each diocese. For example, in our Diocese, for a Baptism, a *suggested offering* to the Priest or parish is \$50. A Wedding is *suggested* at \$500, but the couple can make whatever offering they wish. (Keep in mind, that some weddings cost tens of thousands of dollars--the Church should be adequately recognized as well.) A Funeral is *suggested* at \$350. The Priest does not "pocket" these offerings--they go to operating the Parish. Funeral homes, although they usually include the "church fee" in their final invoice to the family, are instructed by the Diocese to NOT charge the family if they cannot afford it, or if they would rather make their own offering to the

Parish. When you make arrangements at the funeral home, please keep this in mind. The church cannot *charge* for a Funeral Mass.

Quite a while ago, the Priest would keep these offerings for himself--they were called "stole fees". Now, however, the Priest receives a monthly salary, and is well-compensated for his ministry. People though, can give gifts to the Priest, Deacon or Bishop, that he *can* keep for himself.
